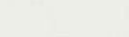

Provided also that the AS shall not be applicable in case electricity produced from offshore wind projects, which are commissioned up to December 2032 and supplied to the GEOA consumer. Provided also that the AS shall not be levied on such open access consumers to the extent of open access availed for wheeling power from their own Captive Power Plants (CPPs).
